Walter Newton Hike: Enjoy a hike through Walter /Newton Natural Area Trail. Please wear appropriate clothing. Walter/Newton Natural Area Trail is a 1.5 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located near Plymouth, New Hampshire that features a waterfall and is good for all skill levels.

Meredith Sculpture Walk: The Meredith Sculpture Walk is an annual (free to the public) exhibit with installations on Main Street, throughout the Mill Falls Marketplace, and in the parks on the shores of Lake Winnepesaukee in in the historic and picturesque village of Meredith. The walk includes 33 sculptures representing artists from all over the northeast. Feel free to pack a snack and enjoy it on the docks or have a bite at one of the many shops and restaurants along the way.

Rattlesnake Hike: Get some fresh air and a fantastic view of Squam, Winnepesaukee, and the surrounding mountains with an easy to moderate hike up Rattlesnake Mountain in Center Sandwich, NH. GORGEOUS! Sturdy shoes and layers are recommended. Directions at the office if needed.

Visit the [Polar Caves Park](#) in nearby Rumney. Created by glaciers during the last ice age, these themed caves are accessed by a trail of boardwalks and stairs. Explore their climbing wall, too.
