Tuesday 10:00am - World's Oldest Covered Railroad Bridge: Originally constructed in 1850 and rebuilt in 1889, the Contoocook Railroad covered bridge is the oldest surviving covered railroad bridge in the United States. The bridge, a double-web town lattice design, originally served the Concord and Claremont Railroad and later served the Boston and Maine when it was acquired in 1887. Wednesday 11:15am - Let's Take a Tour of The Brewing Process at The Woodstock Station - Let's taste and tour the award-winning brews and see and learn about the brewing process.
