The walk includes 33 sculptures representing artists from all over the northeast. Feel free to pack a snack and enjoy it on the docks or have a bite at one of the many shops and restaurants along the way. There will be a \$3.00 fuel charge for this activity. **Wednesday 1:00pm-3:00pm Crafts with Paula:-** Assorted crafts, prices vary.

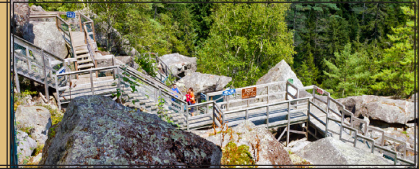

We will leave the docks at Weirs Beach at 10:00 am., and head across lake Winnepesaukee to historic and scenic Wolfeboro. There, you can shop, wander, have lunch and/or visit the WWII Wright Museum. **Fares for the boat are \$51.52 each** (3 and under don't require a ticket). If you choose to go to the museum the admission is Adults: \$16.00, Children (4 and under): Free, Students (5-17): \$8.00 All Military and seniors: \$13.00. There is a **\$4.00 Fuel Charge**.
