Tuesday 11:00am - Meredith Sculpture Walk: The Meredith Sculpture Walk is an annual (free to the public) exhibit with installations on Main Street, throughout the Mill Falls Marketplace, and in the parks on the shores of Lake Winnepesaukee in the historic and picturesque village of Meredith. The walk includes 33 sculptures representing artists from all over the northeast. Feel free to pack a snack and enjoy it on the docks or have a bite at one of the many shops and restaurants along the way. There will be a \$3.00 fuel charge for this activity. Wednesday 11:15am - Let's Take a Tour of The Brewing Process at The Woodstock Station - Let's taste and tour the award-winning brews and see and learn about the brewing process. The tour charge is \$9.00 per person to taste their beers. The tour includes a free pint glass. (If you don't like beer, they also make great root beer). We will be eating at this cool historic old train station. Sign up please; we need 4 for the trip to go. There is a \$3.00 charge for fuel

Thursday - 10:00am - Littleton Trip: Take a scenic ride up to NH new up and coming town Littleton. We will follow route 25. Along the way keep your eyes open for covered bridges and the remains of America's oldest country store! You could have lunch at Schilling Beer Company in Littleton. They offer wood fired pizzas and more! You will have the opportunity to stop into the World's Longest Candy Counter as well as a few other downtown shops! The fuel charge for this trip will be \$4.00 per person.

Explore one of New England's most famous lakes on a [Squam Lake Boat Tour](#), offering guided pontoon boat tours on the lake where "On Golden Pond" was filmed. Learn its history and perhaps spot a Bald Eagle or Loon!
