Wednesday 11:00am - Meredith Sculpture Walk: The Meredith Sculpture Walk is an annual (free to the public) exhibit with installations on Main Street, throughout the Mill Falls Marketplace, and in the parks on the shores of Lake Winnipesaukee in in the historic and picturesque village of Meredith. The walk includes 33 sculptures representing artists from all over the northeast. Feel free to pack a snack and enjoy it on the docks or have a bite at one of the many shops and restaurants along the way. There will be a \$3.00 fuel charge for this activity.
